Wednesday, April 11, 2018: *“First Memories of the Holocaust.”* To commemorate Yom HaShoah (Holocaust Memorial Day), we will discuss our early memories of learning about the Holocaust. In 2018, we now have 70-plus years of scholarship, films, books, plays, etc., to help put the Holocaust in historical perspective. But what are your earliest recollections of hearing of the concentration camps? What were your earliest memories of hearing about the 6 million? What were the reactions of your family members? What were the reactions from your community?

Wednesday, April 18, 2018: *“Moving the U.S. Embassy to Jerusalem.”* In December, 2017, President Trump formally recognized Jerusalem as Israel's capital and announced that the United States will move its embassy to Jerusalem. Was this a good political move by President Trump? What were his motivations? What will be the fallout of this decision? In honor of Yom Ha'atzmaut (Israel Independence Day), we will discuss the future of Jerusalem.

Wednesday, April 25, 2018: *“Ginger or Mary Ann?”* It is an age-old question (...at least since 1964). If you were stranded on a desert island with two different types of women, which one would you choose? On the TV show “Gilligan's Island” two of the female characters were a study in contrasts.
